### Purpose for the FROG Survey

- Help ensure FROG committee efforts are inline with the community
- Build off prior survey results to hone in on preferences
- Identify community prioitries
- Confirm areas to focus FROG resources and donations

### Survey Methods

- $\Box$  Survey Sample Size: n = 278 community members took the survey
  - □ Total started survey: 278
  - □ Total finished survey: 258 (92.8%)
- Population surveyed were frog park patrons and community members
- Recruitment Sample were recruited via:
  - □ The Rockridge News
  - □ List serves Rockridge, Temescal and neighborhood groups
  - Frog park visitors
  - Farmers Market visitors
- Administration:
  - Online using SurveyMonkey and
  - □ Paper surveys and handouts with a link to the survey, were handed out at the park
  - Data Entry:
    - Online survey (n = 129)
    - $\blacksquare$  Paper surveys (n = 149) were manually entered (by Oakland Tech senior and juniors)

	Park features –additional features such as musical stations, play areas for older kids, coffee kiosk, exercise area for adults, climbing structures, see saw, tire swing, and more
	Swings – More
	Safety – General: Areas include: more police patrols, gates, improved sightline in play structure, concern about hand-pedal, etc.
	Maintenance – General: cleanup, maintenance for existing features, trim trees for more sun light, repair gate to Claremont, garbage collection
	Homeless - Help move out: sereval comments to address the homeless/vagrant presence and the need for police intervention.
	Bathroom – Improve, clean and maintain, and add bathrooms: many comments on the state of the current bathrooms, including the lock
	Sandbox - Change to thicker grain, improve and clean sand, donate toys for sandbox, more and toys, bigger play area
	Activities – suggestions include: Basketball leagues, music, movie, potluck day, etc
	Lighting - Better lighting around underpass / basketball area
	Art – Interactive - play compatible
	Creek - running year round
	Dogs - Divided dog areas
	Irrigation - Muddy in grassy area
	Noise – Noise reduction including an artistic sound wall






## Results: Swings at Big Frog /Hardy

#### Results: Art Themes

- Respondents were asked to rate their art preferences for the freeway underpass and the entryway - findings show alignment. The following set of themes received the highest ratings for both venues:
  - Native California Wildlife
  - Native Flowers
  - Frogs
- Notable interest in Mosaics
- Slight higher preference for Kids vs Dogs
- Slight higher preference for Impressionists. Geometric
- Other comments were provided:
  - Historical
  - Sea life continue theme Similar to underpass mural
  - □ Trees Redwood trees painted pillars
  - Frogs-interactive: Huge Green frogs that kids could climb.
  - Method Communally-created would be ideal
  - □ Sign Move kiosk to entrance and add 'welcome to Frog..'

### Results: Tallied Art Theme Ratings – Summary Table

Findings show alignment; the following set of themes received the highest ratings for both venues:

### Survey Demographics

- □ Nearly two thirds of respondents (63%) were Rockridge residents
- Majority of respondents (78%) were between 30-49 years old. The following are respondnet age ranges:

$\square$ 17 or less	0.8%
□ 18-20	0%
21-29	3%
<b>30-39</b>	<b>47</b> %
<b>40-49</b>	31%
<b>50-59</b>	11%
□ 60 or older	8%

- $\square$  Over a third of respondents (n=95) made comments on priority suggestions
- $\square$  A small group (n=15) made comments on art themes.
- About a third of respondents (n=81)provided email address to volunteer and / or keep informed
